The Landscape Planning Subcommittee of the Future Growth Committee has developed a Landscape Plan for the Church that meets the requirements of the City of Dover Overlay Zone. This plan has been approved and covers all areas required by City regulations. Because of the lack of volunteers to maintain the landscaping, the plan emphasizes low maintenance trees, shrubs and groundcover. The plan minimizes the number of plants that require trimming and leaf raking and maximizes the area that can be maintained by mowing.

The Building and Grounds Committee, however, does encourage the addition of landscaping that requires heavier maintenance, such as annual flower beds, perennial flower beds, and attractive shrubbery that requires trimming. To provide for the ability to add such landscaping, the Building and Grounds Committee has prepared this agreement for individuals and groups to identify specific locations that they would like to landscape. Signing this agreement means that the individual or group will take responsibility for purchasing plants, planting, mulching, weeding, pruning, and any other maintenance required for the designated area. If the designated area is not maintained for a period of one year, the individual or group signing this agreement acknowledges that the Building and Grounds Committee may, at its discretion, remove the landscaping and return the location to its previous condition.
