PREPARATION 준비와 찬양

Invocation Prayer 기원

Opening prayer to seek the Lord and prepare the heart and mind for worship.
(Suggested prayer: *Thank you Lord for helping us worship you even through the harsh weather conditions and circumstances of this world. Though we are not physically together, let us be reminded that you are gathering us this morning to worship you with the church around the world, saints of the past, present, and future, and join with the heavenly beings to give you praise and glory. Unite us in heart and mind through the power of your Holy Spirit and help us to wholly give ourselves to you now. We pray in the name of Jesus Christ. Amen.*)

Answer: God created all things by his powerful Word, and all his creation was very good; everything flourished under his loving rule.

58 Therefore, my beloved brothers, be steadfast, immovable, always abounding in the work of the Lord, knowing that in the Lord your labor is not in vain.
